PROGRESS OF COURT CASES ON THREE SECURITY CONTRACTS

Reference is made to the First National Security Council (NSC) meeting - 2014 held on 25<sup>th</sup> February, 2014 in which the Cabinet Secretary for the National Treasury presented a brief NSC(14)7 on the above matter.

SECRET

NSC considered the matter and:-

- i) Directed the Attorney General to compile and present to NSC the complete judicial proceedings and negotiation/mediation processes during the next meeting.
- ii) Directed the Attorney General, and the Cabinet Secretary for the National Treasury to proceed and acknowledge the verdict of the courts but call for negotiations on modalities of payment in order to safeguard the issuance of the forthcoming Sovereign Bond.
- iii) Directed the Cabinet Secretary for the National Treasury to carry out a Cost/Benefit Analysis of payments of these contracts and present to NSC.
- iv) Directed the Cabinet Secretary for the National Treasury, the Cabinet Secretary for Foreign Affairs, the Cabinet Secretary for Defence, and the Attorney General to convene and strategize on how Government communication around this sensitive matter where services were not delivered would be done. The Chief of Staff and Head of Public Service to convene the meeting.
- v) Directed the Cabinet Secretary for National Treasury, the Cabinet Secretary for Foreign Affairs, the Cabinet Secretary for Defence, and the Attorney General to proceed on the basis of what they agree on in the above meeting after briefing the President.

Please take the necessary action.
